[New Report Shows Implications of a Rapidly Aging Homeless Population](#)

[A new analysis](#) from the Actionable Intelligence for Social Policy initiative at the University of Pennsylvania explores the intersection of aging and homelessness.

Based off a multi-site study in three localities -- Boston, New York City, and Los Angeles County -- the report forecasts the size of the homeless population to 2030; projects the costs associated with health care, shelter, and long term care; and outlines potential cost reductions that can be achieved through appropriate housing interventions. 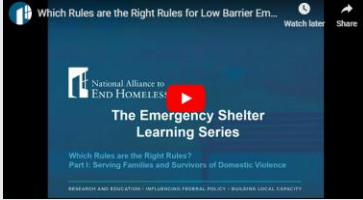
