

2020 Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) Application Workshop Announcement

The Department of Community Affairs (DCA) is announcing the 2020 application process for the Housing Opportunity for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) program. The DCA HOPWA program provides stable housing to low-income persons and families living with HIV/AIDS in its 125 county HOPWA jurisdiction outside of 29-county Metropolitan Atlanta and 5-county Augusta Richmond area.

The applicants will be required to register and receive log-in information for the Housing Solutions Online (HSOnline) application portal. **Applicants are able to Register for login information beginning on Tuesday , March 03, 2020 and ending on Tuesday, March 24, 2020 at 5:00 pm.**

The online application will open on Tuesday, March 03, 2020 and all applications, supporting materials, and organizational documentation will be due on Tuesday, April 07, 2020 at Noon.
