The Alliance invites **homeless service providers** and **advocates** to complete an [anonymous survey](#) related to COVID-19.

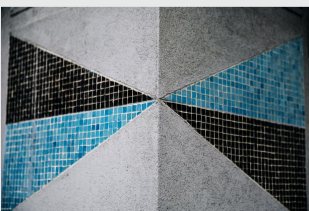
