Emergency Broadband Benefit Program Is Now Available

The Emergency Broadband Benefit Program provides \$50 per month (\$75 for those in tribal lands) to people needing an internet connection, and provides a \$100 discount for an electronic device. The program may be useful to people moving into housing, especially families whose children are still in remote schooling environments.
